- A. Recap of Settlement with SMESPA
- B. Talent Together 12 of our 78 teaching staff are on an alternate pathway to get their teaching certificate. Talent Together is a program that has partnered with area colleges. Talent Together works for teachers who have yet to receive their degrees. Talent Together does a lot of the heavy lifting for these programs to work. Talent Together takes 500 people per cycle. Deadline is March 3rd. They will have 2000 applicants. We will have preferential placement since we applied for the grant last year in addition to being rural. Participants are required to work for 5 years at the host district. We need to ask ourselves: How many alternate path teachers do we want in the district? How does that align with our board policy of hiring certified teachers?
- C. Beyond Basics Program is working for the vast majority of our students. There are some that it did not work for. We know we need to make some wholesale changes to our reading program. Jr/Sr High had 14 students go through the entire program. We have seen 15 months of growth in 3 months in the program at the Jr/Sr High. We have seen 8 months growth at Heritage. Cindy Stacy has been scoping out the program to see if there are some things we could replicate within our programs. We are looking at getting our certified teachers to be able to help test to get kids into the Beyond Basics program as there is a bottleneck with their testers.
- D. MI Student Voice This is a new survey out of Kent ISD. This would be conducted every couple of years. We need to think about how to package this for maximum participation. The goal is to get out right after spring break.
- E. MIPHY- State survey on if students are exposed to cigarettes, drugs, alcohol, abuse
- F. mySAEBRS A very brief survey that kids take a couple times per year.
- G. Other Annual evaluation should be on every employee.
