Reviewed the Preliminary Budget that was adopted. Net increase in foundation, local revenues from taxes, net decrease in federal revenue (grant funds fell off the books), net increase in state revenues.

Big impacts SEA/SAA wage and longevity increases, grounds maintenance, tech updates & retention bonus for all staff.

Fund balance is on the decline. Leaves fund balance at 24% for this year.

State budget we probably will not get until July of this year. We need to trim about 1-1.2 million.
