

## **Student Scholarship Matching Funds Application Instructions**

# PLEASE READ CAREFULLY AS EXPLANTION ALL OF THE RULES AND GUIDELINES THAT MUST BE FOLLOWED FOR APPLICATIONS TO RECEIVE CONSIDERATION ARE BELOW.

Note: Student applicants are NOT required to have any masonic affiliation

The Student Scholarship Matching Grants program was established to support students pursuing an undergraduate college degree by helping to offset the rising costs of higher education. A lodge may apply for scholarship matching funds for students <u>up to \$1,500</u> during <u>the fiscal year April 1 through March 31</u>. Completed applications can be submitted to the Michigan Masonic Charitable Foundation at any time as they are processed weekly. If a lodge wishes to spread its contributions between various students, it can be done through multiple applications at once or throughout the fiscal year.

For example:

Lodge A \$500 - Student 1 \$500 - Student 2 \$500 - Student 3 **\$1,500** Lodge B X \$1,500 - 3 students

April August January Fiscal Year Total

(\$500 each student) \$1,500

## • Who is eligible for the Scholarship Program?

The Matching Student Scholarship Grants program is available for any graduating high school senior or college undergraduate in the State of Michigan who is planning to attend (full-time) an accredited college, university, trade or vocational school. Applicants must reside in Michigan and be a U.S. citizen.

#### • How does a student apply for a scholarship?

# **Note: Students must contact a Michigan Masonic Lodge in their area to receive** <u>AND</u> **submit applications.** A list of all Michigan lodges can be found on the Grand Lodge of Michigan website: grandlodgemi.org/lodges

All applicants must include:

- 1. An official transcript, certified by the school that includes the student's academic record.
- 2. ACT or SAT test scores. These may be photocopied.
- 3. Two letters from school personnel
- 4. Two letters from non-school personnel

## • Where does a lodge find the student scholarship application?

The application is only located on the Grand Lodge of Michigan website: grandlodgemi.org through the member's area portal.

#### How does a lodge submit applications for matching funds?

- 1. Mail or email page 5 of application to the Michigan Masonic Charitable Foundation for approval:
  - <u>Electronic submissions</u>: email completed form to matchingfunds@mmcfonline.org
    Note: With electronic submissions, requested signatures must be handwritten lodge <u>endorsed by a Masonic</u> <u>Lodge in Michigan</u> before submission.
  - <u>Mailed submissions</u>: mail completed form to the Michigan Masonic Charitable Foundation office at 1200 Wright Ave Alma, MI 48801.

IMPORTANT NOTE: If your lodge is providing its own award certificates, please inform the Foundation by using any of the above contact options. If needing award certificates, please send the Lodge Endorsement page (page 4) of the application to the Foundation office as soon as possible to allow enough time to receive award certificates in time for any anticipated student award ceremonies.
