District Owned/Issued Chromebooks

- Chromebooks will be distributed within the first two weeks of the school year.
 - K-5 student chromebooks remain in the classroom
- Parents/Guardians and students <u>MUST</u> sign and return the <u>Stockbridge Acceptable Use Policy</u> before the Chromebook can be issued to any student.
- This Chromebook Policy outlines the procedures and policies for families to protect the Chromebook investment for Stockbridge Community Schools.
- Chromebooks will be collected at the end of each school year.

Fees associated with Chromebooks

Students are responsible for keeping the provided Chromebook in good functioning condition. The following table includes known costs for the most common Chromebook issue, it is not exhaustive.

Technology Acceptable Use Policy Elementary Student Agreement

Stockbridge Community Schools (SCS) has developed a Technology Acceptable Use Policy for the Internet, school networks, computers and related equipment. Access and use of these is a privilege for the user.

- 5. I will not tell anyone my username or password (except my teacher or parent/guardian) and will not use other people's usernames or passwords.
- 6. I will only use software that is provided by the school and will not download or copy software onto the equipment or click on ads
- 7. I will not use the equipment to play games or email/text/blog unless my teacher asks me to.
- 8. I will use the Internet for education only and if I visit a site that is bad or makes me feel uncomfortable, I will tell my teacher.
- 9. I will not give out my name, address, phone number, age, school name, email address or other information about me while using the Internet.
- 10. I will only use my first name and first initial of my last name, my own photo in a group, or my own school work when my teacher asks me to save information to websites.
- 11. I will only do good things while using the equipment. All of my activities using the equipment will be things that my parents and teachers will be proud of. If I do not follow the rules or my teacher's instructions, I may lose my privilege to use the equipment and may be disciplined by the school. I may have to pay the school to fix the equipment that I broke.

SCS Elementary Student Chromebook Insurance

Students and families have the option to purchase insurance to help cover damage to their Chromebook. This insurance will help to cover the cost of repairs if the Chromebook is ever damaged.

Insurance cost is **\$15** to be paid immediately. *This covers* <u>one</u> <u>accidental damage claim per year. Any additional damage is the responsibility of the student/family.</u>

There is a \$75 Family Cap on Chromebook insurance.

If you waive the insurance, please be aware that you are still responsible for any damage to the Chromebook. Please see the table below for cost of repair and replacement.
